

THE TAMIL NADU MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE RULES, 1996.

1. Short title.— These rules shall be called the Tamil Nadu Municipal Corporation Public Health Service Rules, 1996.

2. Constitution. - The Service shall consist of the following Categories of posts in Class I and Class II namely :—

CLASS I—

Category 1

.. City Health Officer.

CLASS II—

Category 1

.. Assistant Health Officer.

Category 2

.. Medical Officer

Category 3

Veterinary Assistant Surgeon

3. Appointment.—Appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below shall be made by the methods specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof :—

THE TABLE.

Name of the post. (1)	Method of recruitment. (2)
City Health Officer	(i) By promotion from the holders of the posts of Categories (1) and (2) of Class II posts ; or (ii) By deputation from the other Corporations or local body services or Government services.
Assistant Health Officer	(i) By transfer from the holders of the post of Medical Officer ; (ii) By deputation of Assistant Health Officer from other Corporations or local body service or from Government Service.
Medical Officer	(i) By direct recruitment ; or (ii) By deputation from other Corporations or local body or Government Service.
Veterinary Assistant Surgeon	By deputation of Veterinary Assistant Surgeon from other Corporations or local body or Government Service.

4. Qualification.—No person shall be appointed to the categories specified in column (1) of the Table below by the method of appointment specified in column (2), unless he possesses the academic and Training Qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof :—

Name of the post. (1)	Method of appointment (2)	Qualification. (3)
City Health Officer	By promotion	Must have worked for a period of not less than three years in each of the posts of Medical Officer and Health Officer.
Assistant Health Officer	By promotion or By transfer	(i) Must have worked for a period of not less than 3 years as Medical Officer; and (ii) Must have passed the Diploma in Public Health.
Medical Officer		Must possess M.B.B.S. Degree.

5. Promotions.—The promotions to all the categories in these rules shall be made in accordance with seniority and appointment on deputation shall be made only when no qualified person is available in the Corporation Service.

6. Tests and Training.—The holder of any post under these rules, in addition to the Tests and Trainings prescribed for the posts under these rules will have to pass such other Test or undergo such other training that may be prescribed by the Government in the form of an order from time to time.

7. Savings.—Nothing contained in these rules shall adversely affect any person holding any of the posts referred in these rules on the date of coming into force of these rules.

THE TAMIL NADU MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS PUBLIC HEALTH SUB ORDINATE SERVICE RULES,
1996.

1. Short title.—These rules shall be called the Tamil Nadu Municipal Corporations Public Health Sub-ordinate Service Rules, 1996.

2. Constitution.—The Service shall consist of the following categories of posts in Class III, namely :—

Class III :

Group I—

Category 1 — Sanitary Inspector.

Group II—

Category 1 — Staff Nurse,

Category 2 — Pharmacist.

Category 3 — Health Visitor.

Category 4 — Multi-purpose Worker (Male).

Category 5 — Multi-purpose Worker (Female).

3. Appointment.—Appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below shall be made by the methods specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof :—

THE TABLE.

Name of the post. (1)	Method of recruitment. (2)
Sanitary Inspector	— By deputation from Government Service or from Municipal Service or from other Corporation; or By promotion from the holders of the posts in categories 3, 4, 5 of Group-II of this service.
Staff Nurse	.. (i) By promotion from the holders of the post of Health visitors (Female) or (ii) By deputation of Staff-Nurse from other Corporations or local body or Government Service or (iii) By direct recruitment.
Pharmacist	.. (i) By deputation of pharmacists from other Corporations or local body or Government Service or (ii) By transfer from the holder of the post of Health Visitor or (iii) By direct recruitment.
Health Visitor	.. By promotion from the holders of the post of Multi-purpose Health Workers (Female).
Multi-purpose Health Worker (Male).	.. By direct recruitment
Multi-purpose Health Worker (Female).	.. By direct recruitment

4. Qualification.—No persons shall be appointed to the categories specified in column (1) of the Table below by the method of appointment specified in column (2), unless he possesses the academic and training qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof:—

THE TABLE.

Name of the post. (1)	Method of appointment. (2)	Qualification. (3)
Sanitary Inspector	By deputation	Must be a B.Sc. (Chemistry) graduate and must have passed Food Inspectors' Course and Sanitary Inspectors' Course conducted by any Institution recognised by the Government of Tamil Nadu.
	By promotion	(i) Must be a B.S.c. (Chemistry) graduate and must have passed Food Inspector's course and Sanitary Inspectors' Course conducted in any Institution recognised by the Government of Tamil Nadu; and (ii) Must have worked in any post in Group II of the Service for a period of not less than three years.
Staff Nurse	By direct recruitment	Must have passed the Diploma in Staff Nursing Course.
Pharmacist	By direct recruitment or By promotion.	Must possess a Diploma in Pharmacy.
Health Visitor	By promotion.	Must have undergone the training conducted by the Government or Government recognised institute.
Multi-purpose Health Worker (Male)	By direct recruitment	Must have passed Higher Secondary School Examination and one year training course conducted by the Government.
Multi-purpose Health Worker (Female)	By direct recruitment	(i) Must have passed Higher Secondary School Examination and (ii) Must have passed the 18 month training course conducted by the Government.

5. Promotion.—Promotions to all categories of post shall be made in accordance with seniority and direct recruitment shall be made to categories (1) and (2) in Group II, when deputationists are not available in a particular year.

6. Tests and Training.—The holder of any post under these rules, in addition to the Tests and Trainings prescribed for the posts under these rules will have to pass such other Test or undergo such other training that may be prescribed by the Government in the form of an order from time to time.

7. Savings.—Nothing contained in these rules shall adversely affect any person holding any of the posts preferred in these rules on the date of coming into force of these rules.
